Um, and I just was absolutely terrified and felt sick. And then afterwards he said to me, "Did you come?" and I didn't know what he was on about. And I just, kind of, leapt up, leapt off the sofa and I can remember seeing my brother, who was probably about two at the time toddling. And he was, he'd obviously been in bed having a sleep and he was coming down the stairs and coming, going into the hall.
